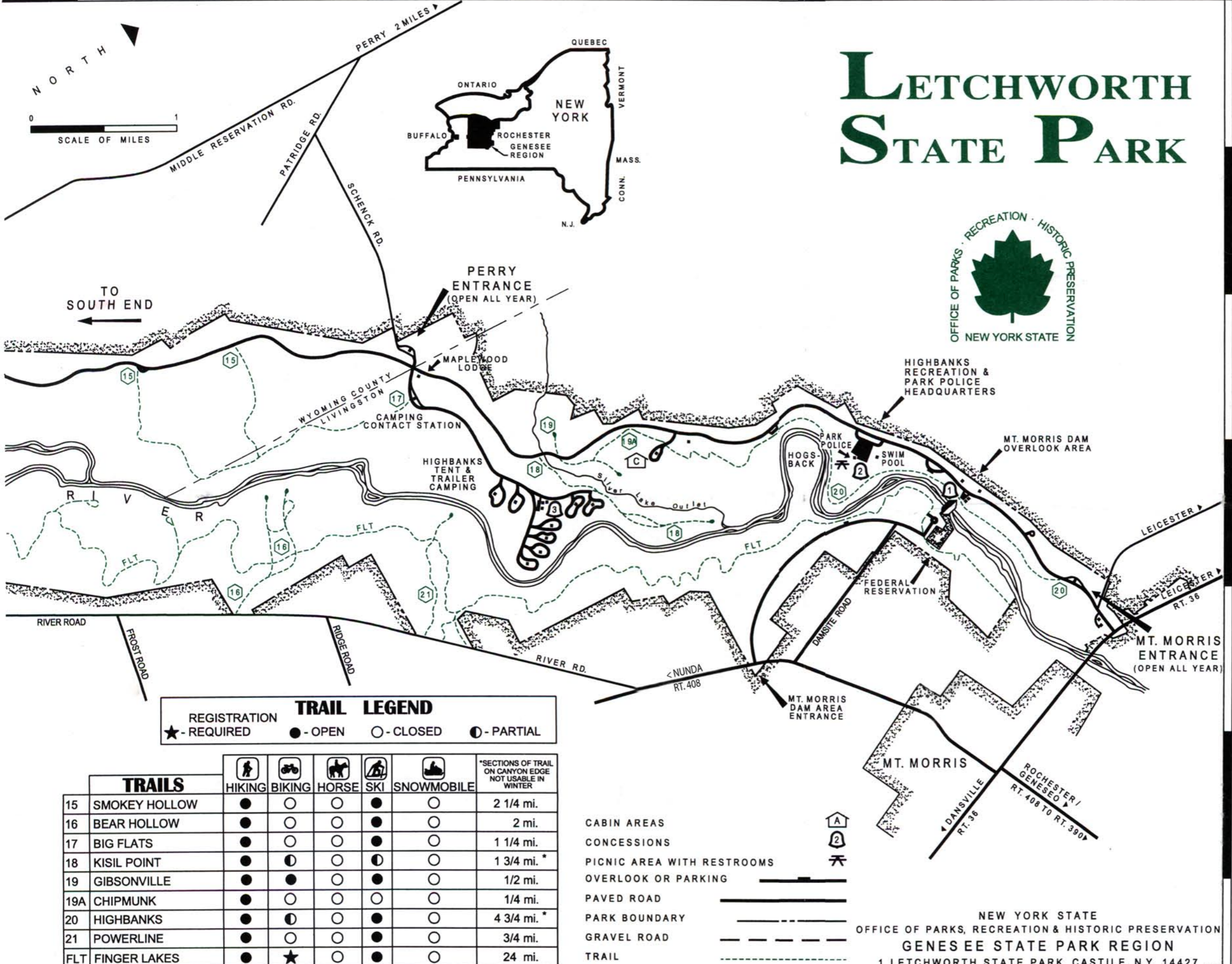

LETCHWORTH STATE PARK

Letchworth State Park comprises 14,350 acres of scenic magnificence along the Genesee River, just 35 miles south of Rochester, New York. The precipitous walls of the Genesee River gorge, the river winding below, the plunge and spray of dramatic waterfalls, and the lush forest all contribute to make the park one of the most notable examples of waterfall and gorge scenery in the eastern United States. Within the park, the Genesee River roars over three major waterfalls, one of which is 107 feet high. Each year the river cuts deeper into the dramatic cliffs which approach 600 feet in height.

FACILITIES - Letchworth offers many leisure time pursuits. Cabins, campsites, swimming pools, museum, Glen Iris Inn and Restaurant, concessions, fishing areas, picnic shelters, winter sports facilities, and an inviting multi-use trail network.

ACTIVITIES - Letchworth offers nature and history programs, special events and festivals, guided walks and tours, summer lecture series and camper recreation programs. Winter activities include snow tubing, cross-country skiing, snowmobiling, and ice skating. Deer and turkey hunting are allowed by permit. Whitewater rafting, canoeing, kayaking, hot air balloon rides and guided horseback trail rides round out the fun.

CAMPING - 270 electric campsites at the Highbanks Tent and Trailer Area. Amenities: bathroom/shower buildings, camp store, laundry, recreation hall. Open mid-May to late October. Groups may use a 30 site primitive camping area; contact Visitor Center for information.

CABINS - 82 cabins ranging from simple, rustic one-room cabins to 3-room, wood paneled cabins. Cabins accommodate 2 - 6 people. Cabins generally rented April-December, some year-round.

RESERVATIONS - Call 1-800-456-2267. Reservations are recommended. Unreserved cabins and campsites are available on a first-come first-served basis.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Complete Park Rules and Regulations are posted throughout the park and at the Visitor Center.

PARK HOURS - 6 a.m. - 11 p.m. Year round.

CARRY IN - CARRY OUT - Everything day visitors bring into the park (carry in) they are required to take home (carry out). This includes all trash and garbage.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES - Permits are required for groups to possess and/or consume alcohol. Minimum age 21.

SWIMMING - Swimming is permitted in the swimming pools only when lifeguards are on duty. Swimming in the Genesee River is prohibited.

FIRES - Please help protect Letchworth; build fires only in grills or fireplaces.

PETS - Pets must be leashed (6ft. max.) at all times. Certificate of rabies inoculation required. Pets are prohibited from all park buildings, pools, and cabin areas.

FIREARMS - Firearms are not permitted except during special hunting season by park permit.
